### TECHNICAL DOCUMENT

The National Cycling Centre-Atlantic Canada, in partnership with the Mike's Bike Shop Cycling Club and the City of Dieppe, are happy to invite you to the 2010 Atlantic Track Open Championships. This race will be held on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 (the 2<sup>nd</sup> will serve as a rain date) at the Caisse populaire Dieppe Velodrome. Cyclists from all Atlantic Provinces are invited to attend.

A free track 101 will be held the morning (from 9 am) of the race for those who have never ridden on a Velodrome. It will be possible to use the rental bikes available at the Centre).

### EVENTS

#### **Prologue / individual pursuit**



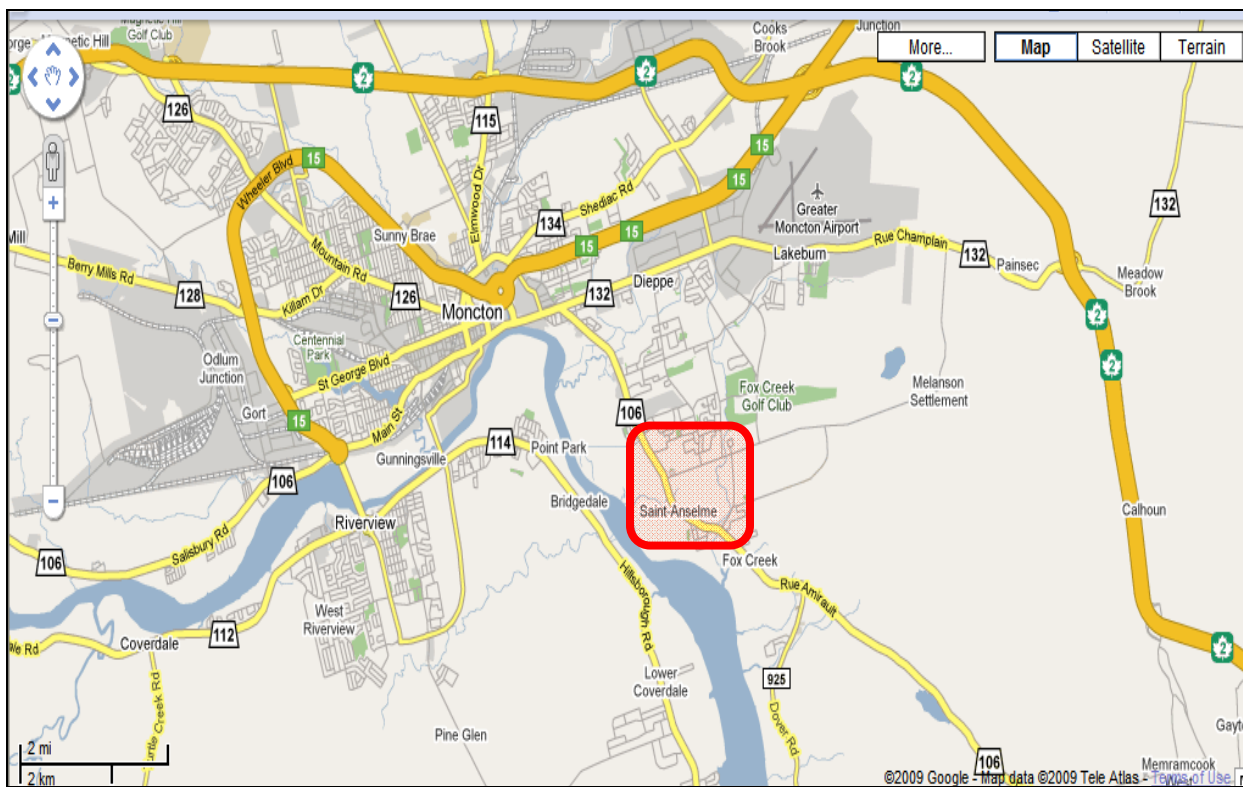
The first event, held on the 26th at 11 am, will be a 2000m individual pursuit on the Caisse populaire Dieppe Velodrome. This event will be used to rank the cyclists in the various categories (A, B, C, and D (for day licensed riders) so everyone can race within their ability level.

#### **Atlantic Open Track Championships**



These championships will be decided over 3 events: 200 m match sprint, points race, scratch race, and elimination race on Sunday. Races will start from 11 am. The Atlantic Track Champion will be determined at the end of the day (omnium format)

## SPECIAL REGULATION

### Categories

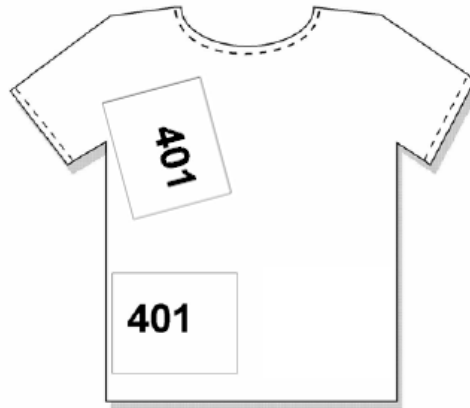
Based on your 2000 m time. Riders will be ranked in A, B, C, and D groups.

### Notification

- Track bike mandatory (20 bikes – small, medium, large – are available at the Centre if needed).
- Track 101 course (mandatory if you never raced on the vélodrome) starting at 9 am (until 11:00)
- Open track time from 9:00 to 11:00 for warm up and training.
- Atlantic Track Open Omnium Points (rider with less points wins)

### Track races

- Events:
  - 2000 m
  - 200 m / match sprint
  - Points race
  - Scratch
  - Elimination
- Numbers:



- Atlantic Track Open Omnium Points in each event (rider will less points wins)
  - Winner: 1 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> position: 2 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> position: 3 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> position: 4 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> position: 5 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> position: 6 point
  - Etc.
  - Non starters: last place + 1 point

## **Awards and prizes**

- Track
  - General classification by points (individual pursuit, sprint, points, scratch and elimination)
    - Top 3 in each category: medals
    - Draw prizes

## **Registration**

- Registration (20\$) must be completed on-line at [www.AtlanticCyclingCentre.com](http://www.AtlanticCyclingCentre.com) before, July 31<sup>st</sup>, midnight. Late fee of 5\$ will apply after that for the road and track events.
  - Registration cost includes track 101 (30\$ value).
  - Licence check and package will take place at the Atlantic cycling Centre from 9:30 am to 10:30 am before the race.
